

# THE POSTGRADUATE SEMINAR

The Postgraduate Seminar is the focal point of BCV's postgraduate program, and enables students and faculty to benefit from and interact with the results of research being undertaken.

Seminars are scheduled three times per semester. Students whose dissertation involves human research are invited to enrol in Research Methods (RM 895), the Doctor of Ministry equivalent.

Usually there will be a workshop on some critical aspect of research methodology for all newcomers to the course beginning an hour before the seminar. The format of the Seminar is as follows: Presenter delivers his/her paper (30 minutes); Discussion (30 minutes). The Seminar concludes with afternoon tea.
